## LOCAL RULES

#### 1. Staked Trees

If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches a staked tree and/or the bark chippings at their bases or such the staked tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 16.1f.

#### 2. Abnormal Course Conditions including Ground Under Repair (Rule 16.1)

Players may take relief under rule 16.1 for animal droppings, animal damage, tyre ruts made by course machinery, etc.

# 3. Abnormal Course Conditions; Play Prohibited (Rule 16.1)

All areas that are marked Ground Under Repair are abnormal course conditions from which play is prohibited and from which the player MUST take relief under Rule 16.1.

#### 4. Out of Bounds (Rule 18.2)

The cottage and gardens between the 14th and 15th holes, as defined by the white stakes, are out of bounds.

#### 5. Paths & Roads (Rule 16.1)

All roads and paths on the course even if not artificially-surfaced, are treated as immovable obstructions from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.

#### Immovable Obstructions including Fixed Sprinkler Heads close to the putting green (Rule 16.1a)

In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, when a ball lies in the general area, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is: on the player's line of play, is within two club-lengths of the putting green, and is within two club-lengths of the ball. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. (Exception – There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable).

#### BEFORE PLAY, ALL GOLFERS ARE ADVISED TO:

Ensure they are adequately insured whilst playing golf. Carry a Rule Book at all times. Make themselves aware of temporary local rules as displayed in the Clubhouse or website.

#### SMART GOLFING ATTIRE IS REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES. PLUS:

Men's shirts must have sleeves and a collar, polo or turtle neck. They must be always tucked in. Shorts provided they are tailored may be worm with long socks or any white ankle or trainer socks. Ladies sleeveless shirts must have collars. No jeans, trainers or tracksuits allowed – Golf caps should be worn with peak forward.

#### PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES

Match Play – Loss of hole; Stroke play – Two strokes.

#### DISTANCE MARKERS

Both 150 yard posts and sprinkler heads denote yardage to the centre of the green.

#### HEALTH & SAFETY

- Thunder & Lightning Players must take individual responsibility for their safety in relation to staying safe from lightning, irrespective of whether a klaxon is heard or not.
- Visibility The golf course will not be opened for play unless the first bunker can be clearly seen from 1st tee (white).
- Medical Emergencies i) Call an ambulance / 999 ii) Contact the Clubhouse on 01932 227345 iii) Start CPR if you are trained/confident to do so.
- 4. Greenkeeper Priority Greenkeepers have priority on the course. The ball must not be played if they are in range. They will give way when practicable. Please wait until it is clear, or you are called through.
