

THE DRESS CODE

WOULD ALL GOLFERS PLEASE ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING DRESS CODE:

On the Courses

- Recognised golfing attire is required at all times. This includes attire as worn on the main professional tours
- Men's shirts should be tucked in to trousers/shorts unless specifically designed to be worn loose
- Ladies may wear sleeveless shirts with a collar
- Shorts may be worn but they must be tailored
- Shorts can be worn with long, ankle or trainer socks of any colour
- Trainers, jeans, tracksuits and numbered polo shirts are NOT permitted on the golf course
- Peaked caps must be worn with the peak forward
- Men may not wear $\frac{3}{4}$ length cut off trousers

In the Clubhouse

- No headwear is permitted within the clubhouse
- Smart Casual dress including denim is accepted in all areas of the club, however ripped jeans are not permitted
- Socks and sliders are not permitted footwear

The dress code is for the benefit of all golfers and we request that all golfers wear the appropriate attire. The result of wearing the incorrect attire may lead to you not being allowed on the golf course or to enjoy the facilities.

All staff have the authority to decide on the appropriate level of dress.
