



DRESS CODE

Our Club embraces a “home away from home” atmosphere, where the dress code is relaxed yet appropriate across all areas - including the Courses, Practice Areas, Clubhouse and Terrace.

As a general guide, golf apparel or footwear purchased from a professional shop or golf-specific retailer is acceptable for play.



GOLF COURSE & PRACTICE AREA

Men: Golf shirts and attire as worn on professional golf tours are acceptable. Shirts should be tucked in unless designed to be worn untucked and must have sleeves.

Ladies: Sleeveless shirts with a collar are permitted.

Headwear: Golf caps should be worn with the peak facing forward.

Shorts: Tailored shorts are permitted and should be worn with colour-coordinated sports socks (long, short, or ankle)



IN THE CLUBHOUSE

Headwear is not permitted inside the clubhouse.

Smart casual dress, including denim, is accepted throughout the clubhouse. However, ripped jeans are not permitted anywhere on the premises.

Golf shoes may be worn in the downstairs areas, including Golf Reception, the Captains' Bar, and the Honours Bar.

Substantial sandals are permitted, but flip-flops are not.

The Club Management reserves the right to ask any person to leave the premises if their attire is considered inappropriate or below expected standards.

Members and Visitors are reminded that changing of clothing should take place in the changing rooms, not in the car park or on the courses
